

Your Driving Record:

Your driving record, also called a driver's abstract, is a record of your basic driving history. It lists when your driver's licence was first issued, plus any driving tickets or other offences you've received in the previous five years.

Get your driving records online

You can easily request a driver's abstract, an insurance and claims history record or a commercial driving record (National Safety Code abstract) for your employer through our online application form.

Once you complete the application, you'll receive an email with your requested records within a few minutes. If you don't see the email, please check your spam or junk folder first then try your request again.
